We have had a relatively quiet winter in Spirit Lake East. Our roads stayed in good condition, and we had few complaints about snow removal. Now we can begin our Spring grading and road repair. The Road Committee has plans for adding gravel to more sections of road and, as funds permit, continuing work to correct drainage problems. Efforts have been slowed, but certainly not stopped, by an expensive grader repair this winter.

TRY THIS FOR A NOVEL IDEA! Those of us who are physically sound can help with our roads. We can remove the larger rocks from the ditches. Just throw any rock bigger than two inches at least three feet behind the ditch or any place where they can't roll back into the ditch. This will eliminate the need for a paid worker to back-track after grading has been done. Anyone doing this around their property will be an
