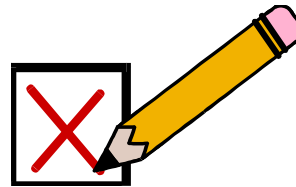
It is also time to think about who you want running your Association for the next 1, 2 or 3 years. We WILL be electing Board

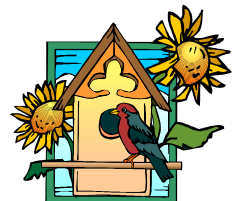

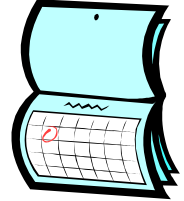

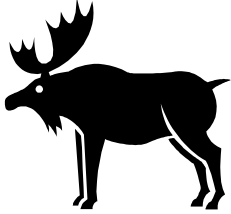
