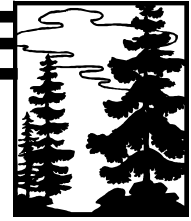

Meeting report

Our semi-annual membership meeting was held May 9, 2006, at Timberlake High School. There were 83 lots represented at the meeting, and 25 lots represented by proxy, for a total of 108 lots. Since this does not constitute a quorum, which requires 133 lots to be represented, the results of the road assessment vote are largely irrelevant. However, it seems significant that there were 86 votes cast in favor of the road assessment, and only 16 against.

Those present, either in person or by proxy, did vote for the new board members, with Mike Schmidt and Lowell Hayes being re-elected, and Paul Peloquin being the new member.

Thank you to all who volunteered to run for board positions! We truly appreciate your willingness to participate and be involved!!

Are You Looking for High Speed Internet?

We found a source for high speed internet that does not depend on the local phone lines. It is called Skynet; it is Wireless and faster than DSL or Cable.

They have a tower over on the mountain between Spirit Lake and Twin Lakes. They have also installed an antenna on our home. If you can get line of sight to either one, you can get the high speed internet. We are the highest point in Spirit Lake East so many homes can see our roof from their roof.
